Total net generation of subsidiary power plants in October 2023 increased by 2.2% year on year to 13,631,716 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 14.0% year on year to 2,856,802 MWh mainly due to the year-on-year decline in wind speed, subsidiary photovoltaic plants increased by 177.2% year on year to 299,920 MWh.

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first ten months of 2023 increased by 3.5% year on year to 156,817,214 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms increased by 9.4% year on year to 31,460,153 MWh, subsidiary photovoltaic plants increased by 100.7% year on year to 2,277,588 MWh.
